
### Over time comparison of average values







I no longer wish to be at Bocconi. Although I appreciated the rigour and quality of what I learned in my Bachelor years, I have two main issues with doing a Master's at Bocconi: 1. Way too theoretical. Masters are about gaining practical knowledge, and, I am sorry to say this, but Bocconi is not good at that. You are too focused on theory. 2. The professors do not know how to speak English. This is a major issue that has occurred in all three years at Bocconi, and one I know continues for Master's students. You guys need to more thoroughly evaluate the English levels of your professor because I can assure you, many of them speak very bad English, making it very hard to students to learn when a professor cannot communicate and mispells everything. If you cannot get professors that speak English, don't have programs in English.

The systems at Bocconi are antiquated, study abroad is a perfect example, when I got to my exchange university it turned out that some courses which I expected to be offered weren't and so I had to take three exams in the last and only session available to me which left me uncertain about graduation. Bocconi needs to deal with issues like this, study abroad should not put my chances of graduation at risk and in terms of exchanging courses, if Bocconi does not trust that the economics track of a partner university will live up to the quality that it expects then why offer it as an option? Support in Bocconi was in my experience extremely poor, as was communication and flexibility in helping students. I taught myself most of the content for courses without attending classes because the teaching method at Bocconi does not engage students in the classroom. I of course loved my experience and feel well prepared but feel that these areas cemented my decision not to continue with ESS.






