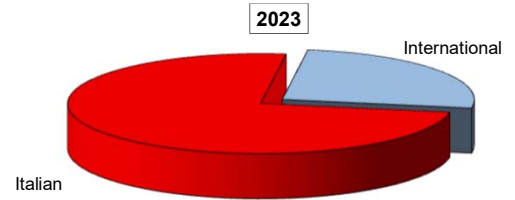

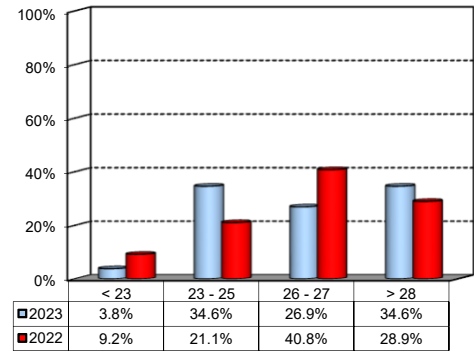

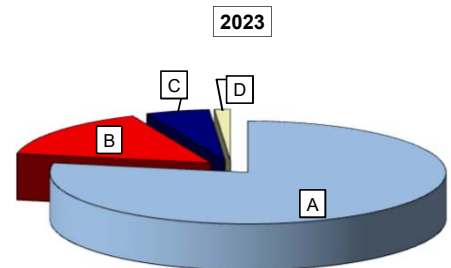

How many of the courses included in your curriculum did you attend regularly?

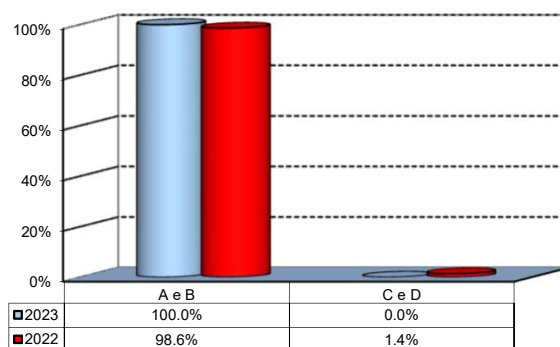

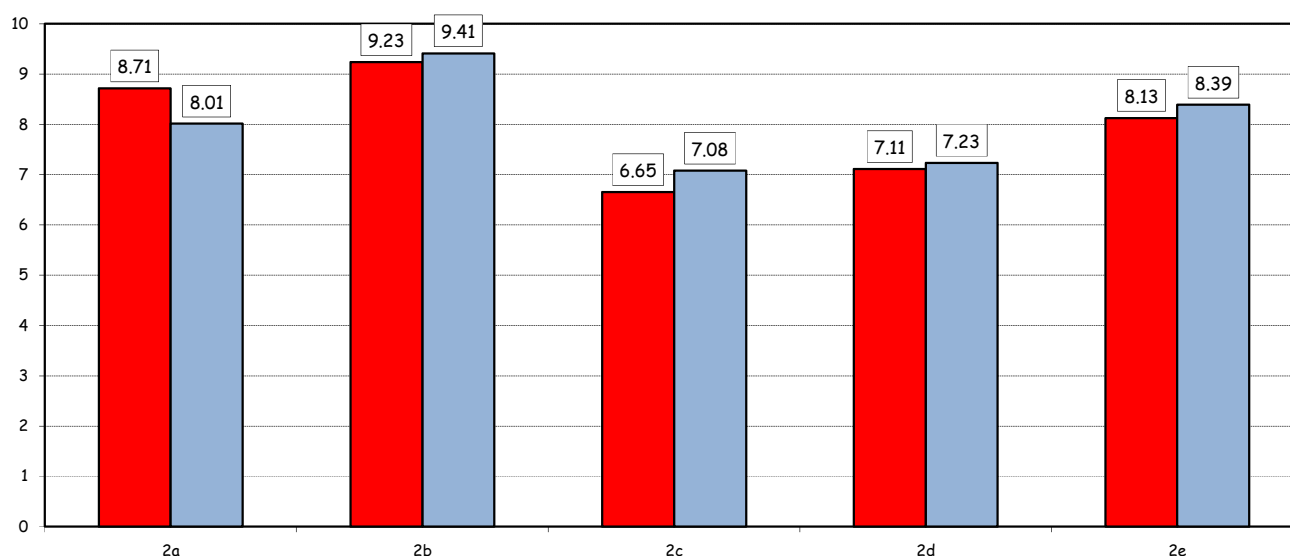

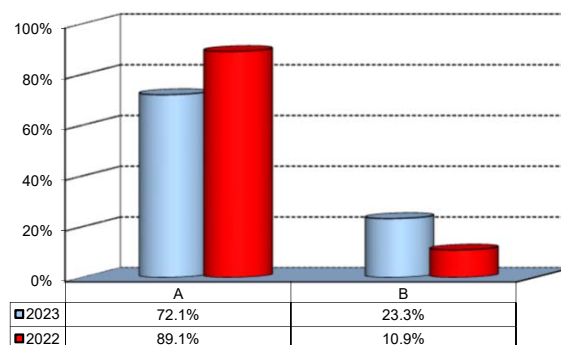

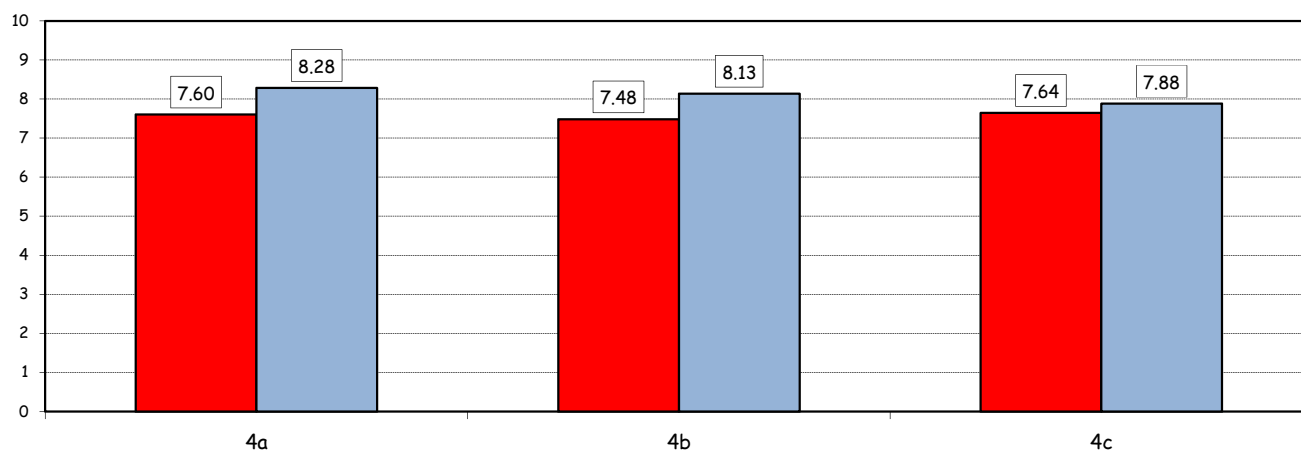

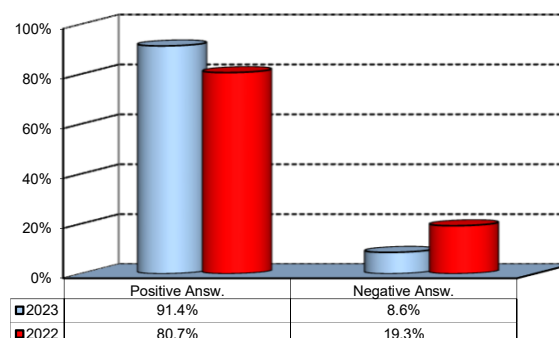

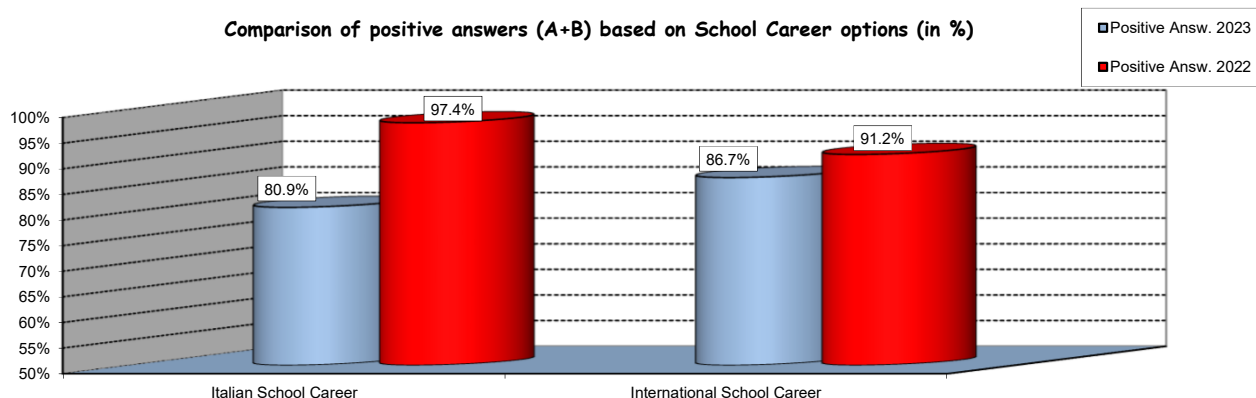

Comparison of positive answers (A+B) based on School Career options (in %)



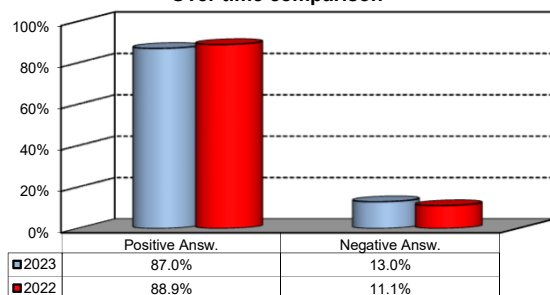

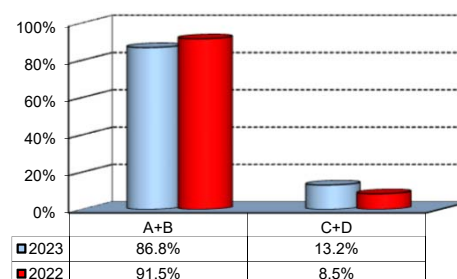

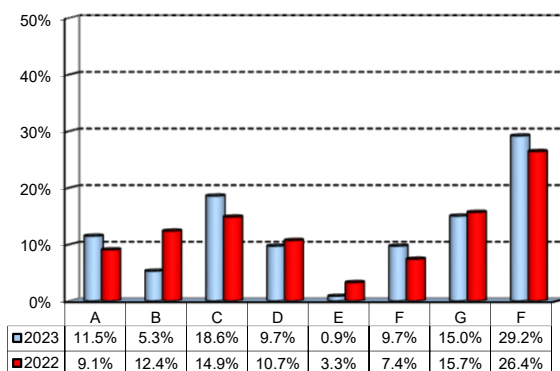

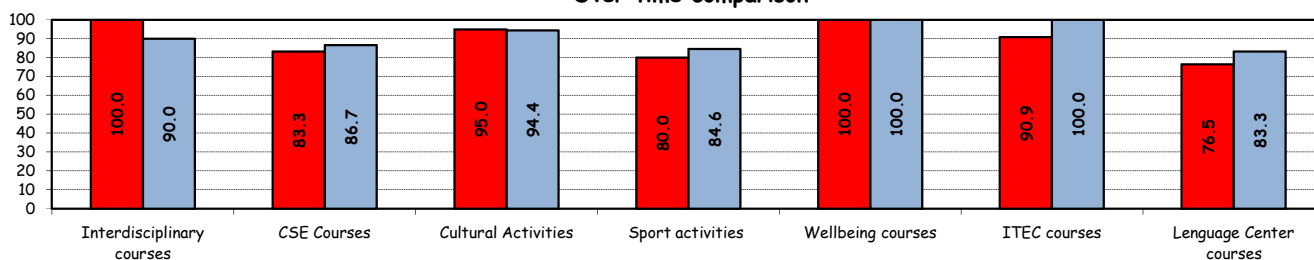

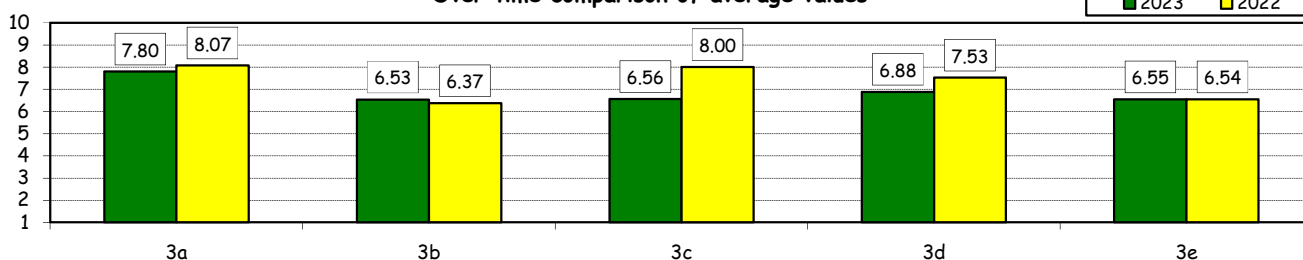

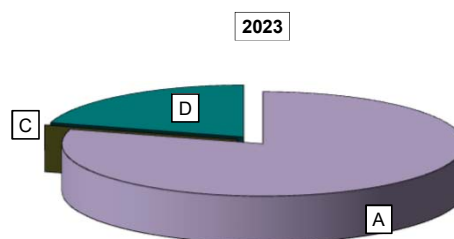
Over time comparison of average values

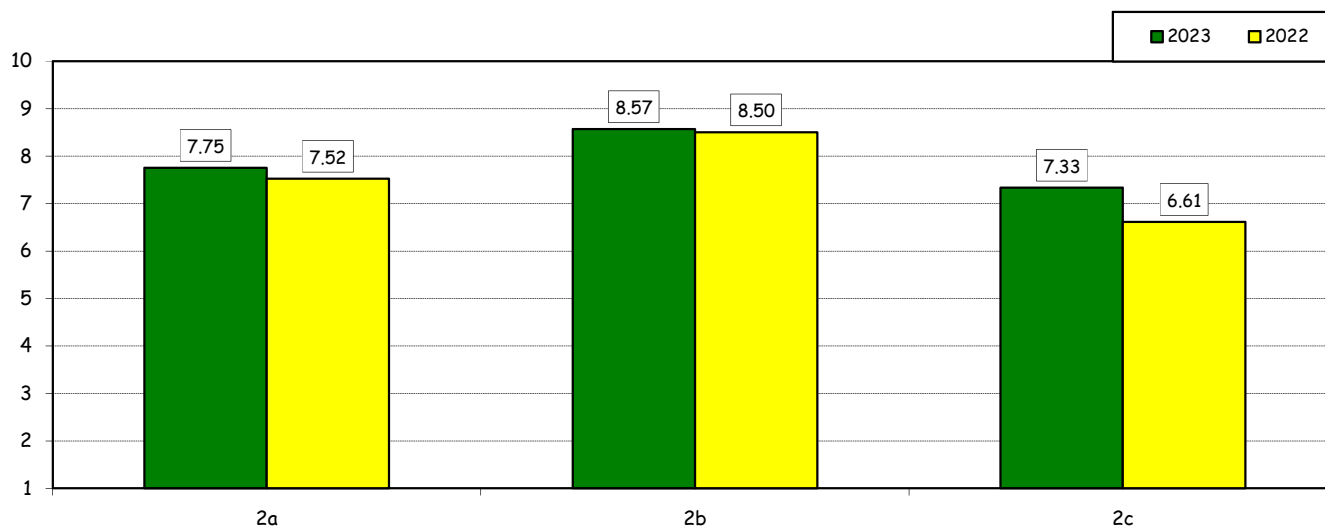

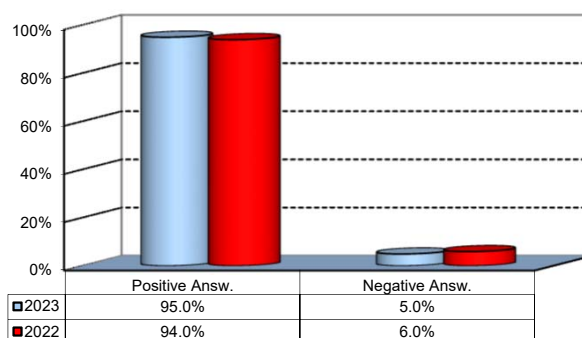
Over time comparison of average values

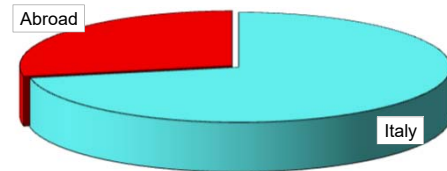

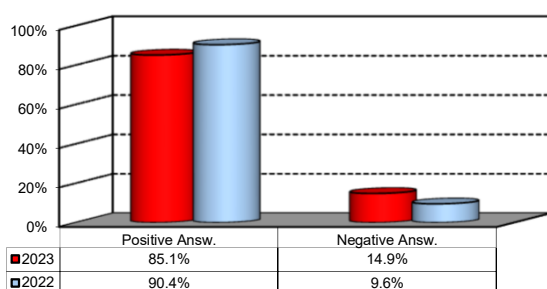

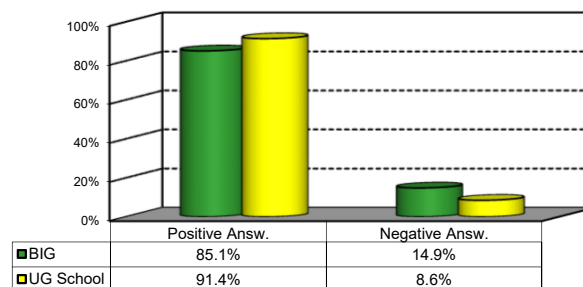

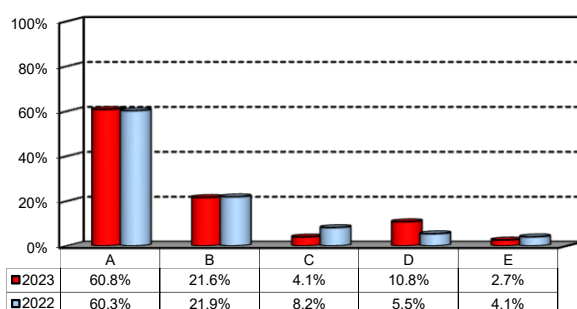

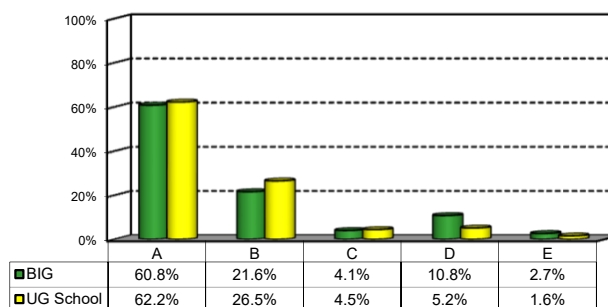

I enjoyed staying at Bocconi University 3 years as an international student, but I wouldn't recommend staying longer i.e. 5 years total i have completely different interests i will pursue elsewhere

I prefer structures of Project Based learning to the exam centric Bocconi system. I also would be looking for a STEM degree which is not Bocconi's specialty

I want to attend a course regarding a subject that is not proposed at Bocconi.

In the future, I would like to work in a country other than Italy due to the general lack of opportunities here. (I thus need to study somewhere else to make my contacts somewhere else). I also do not like the evaluation methods at Bocconi, I think that an MCQ reveals nothing but a student's ability to memorize something and then spit it back out.

The typical style of teaching at Bocconi and admin inefficiency pushed me to attend a different university. The emphasis on memorizing for exams rather than application of coursework made me feel unprepared to begin a job - so I looked elsewhere.
