This statistical report summarizes the opinions expressed by graduates in response to satisfaction surveys conducted 1, 3 and 5 years after graduation. The data reported refer to graduates of the program in question who earned their graduate degree in the 2021-22, 2019-20 and 2017-18 a.y. respectively.

The following are the results of the surveys regarding:

- satisfaction with the program and the set of knowledge and skills acquired at the end of it;
- the perception of the usefulness of the course of study for the performance of one's job;
- impressions of the contribution provided by internship and study experiences abroad (if applicable) upon entering the world of work.

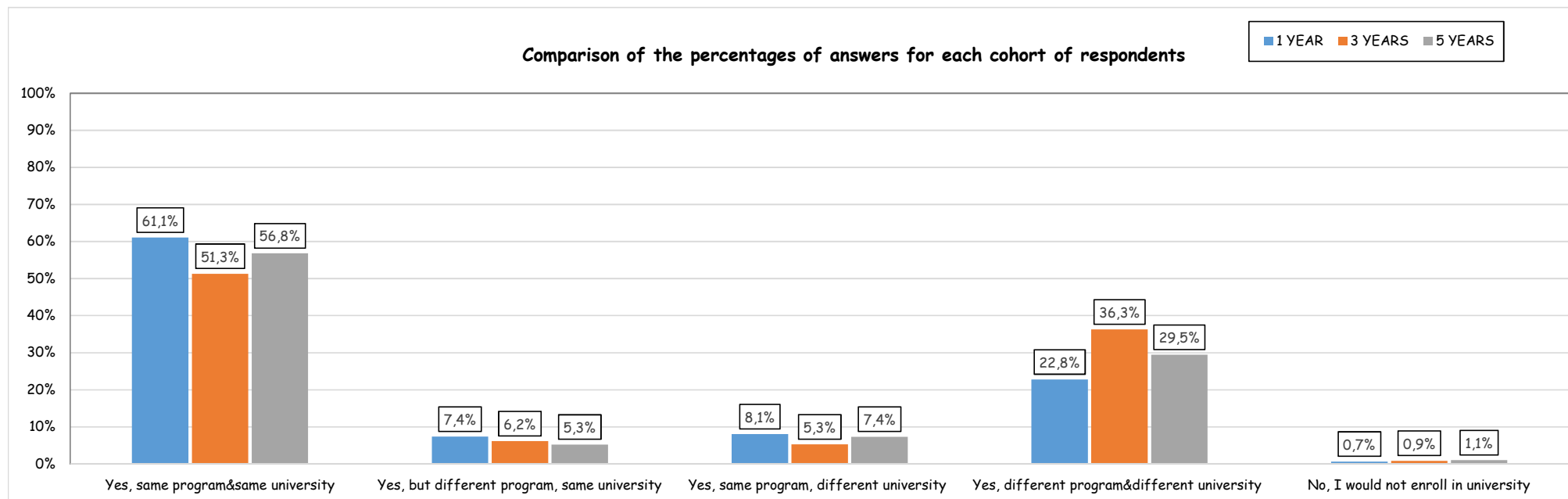

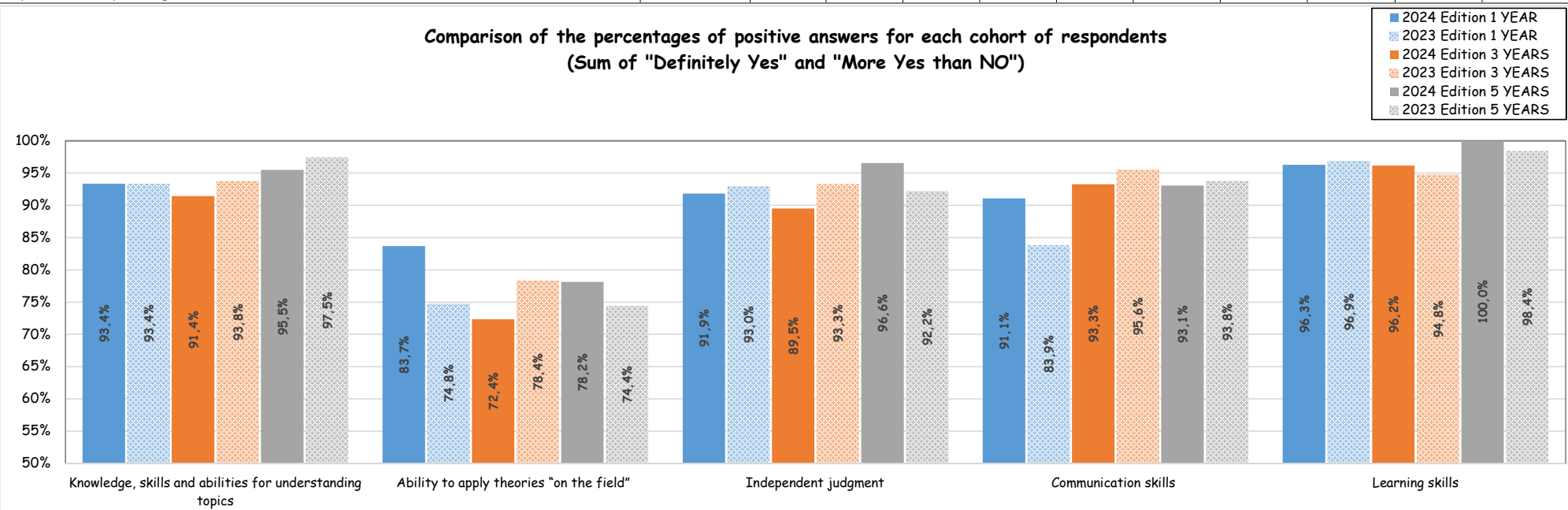

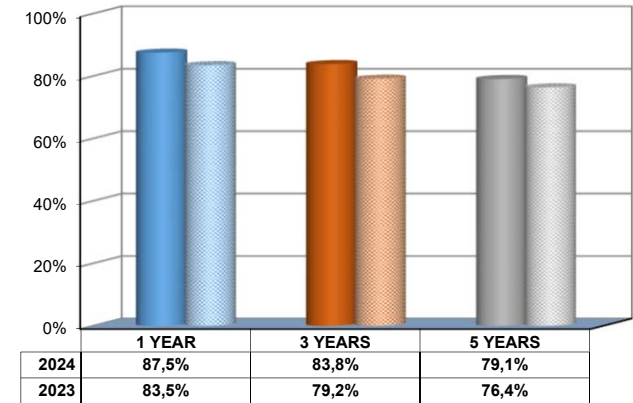

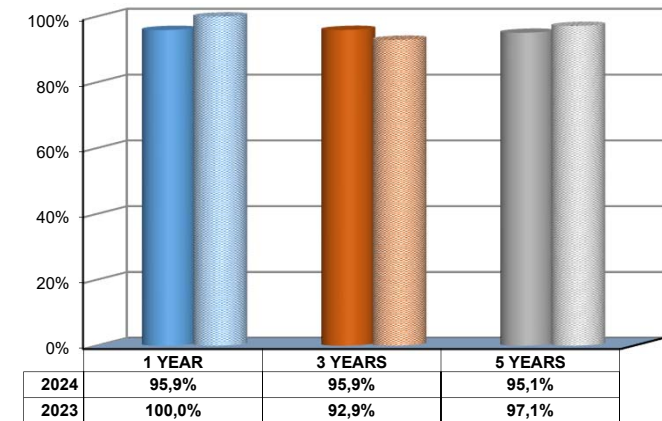
Temporal comparison of the percentage of positive answers
