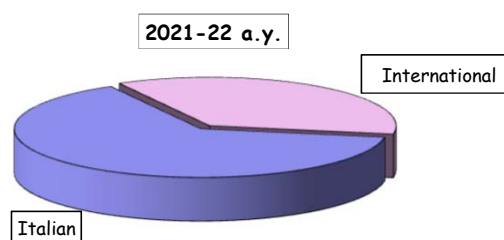

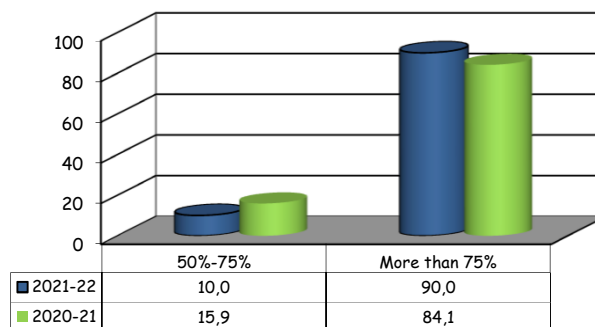

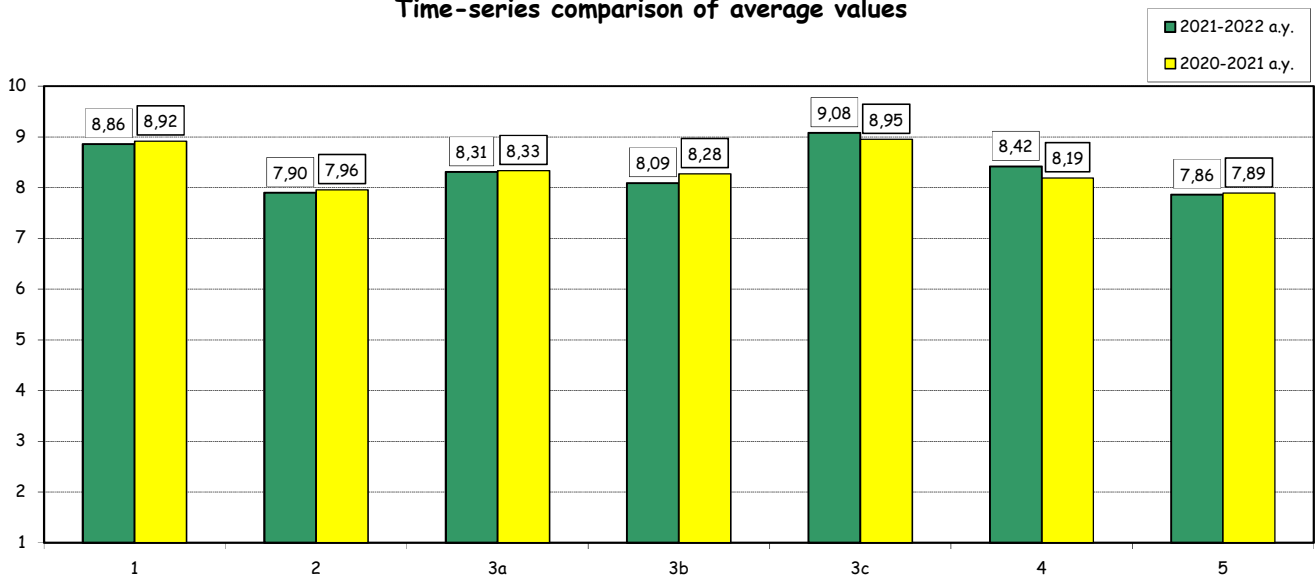

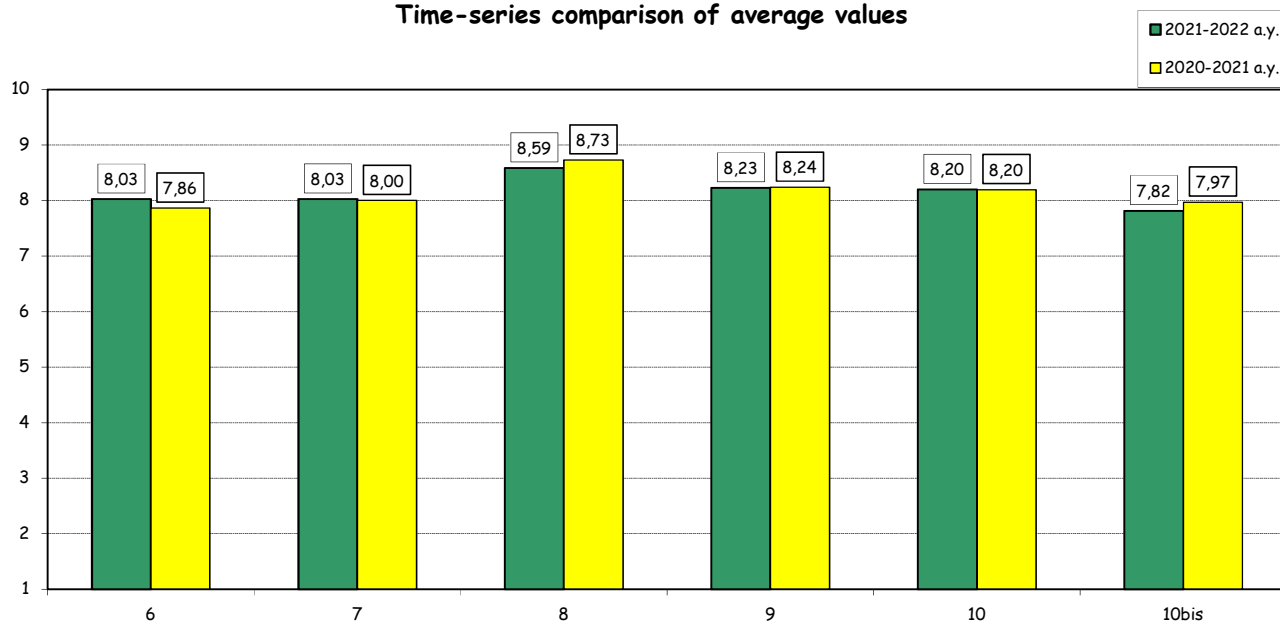

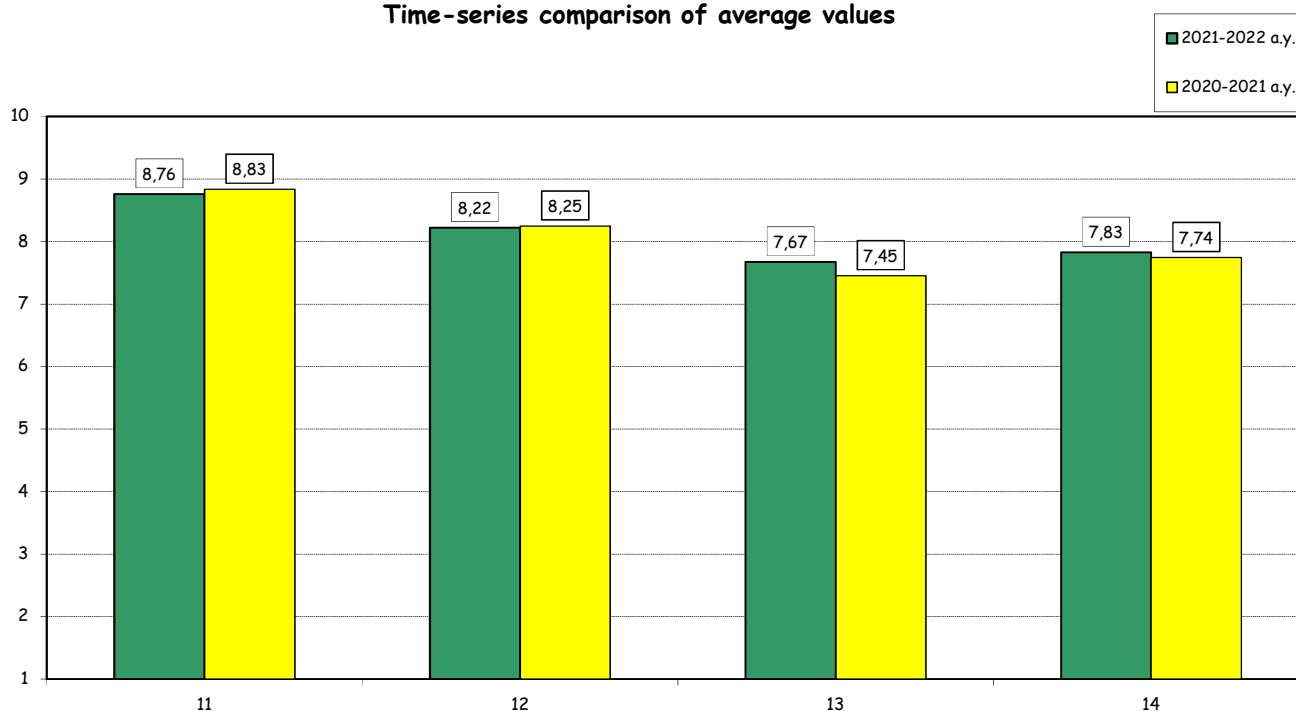

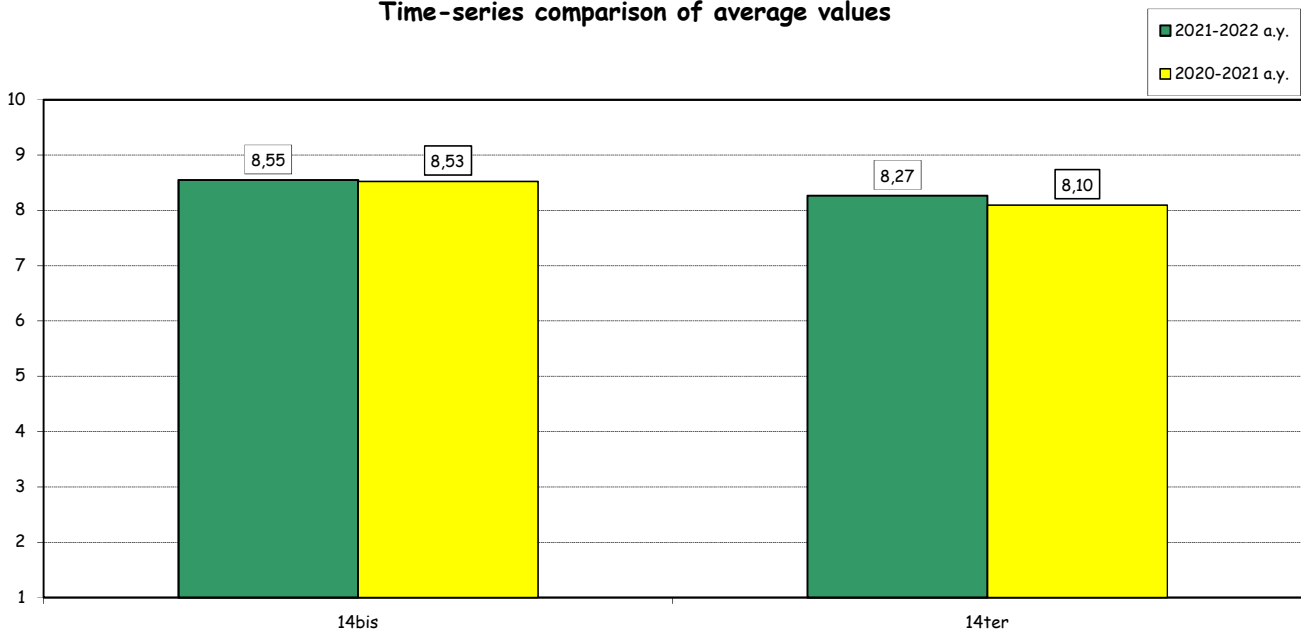

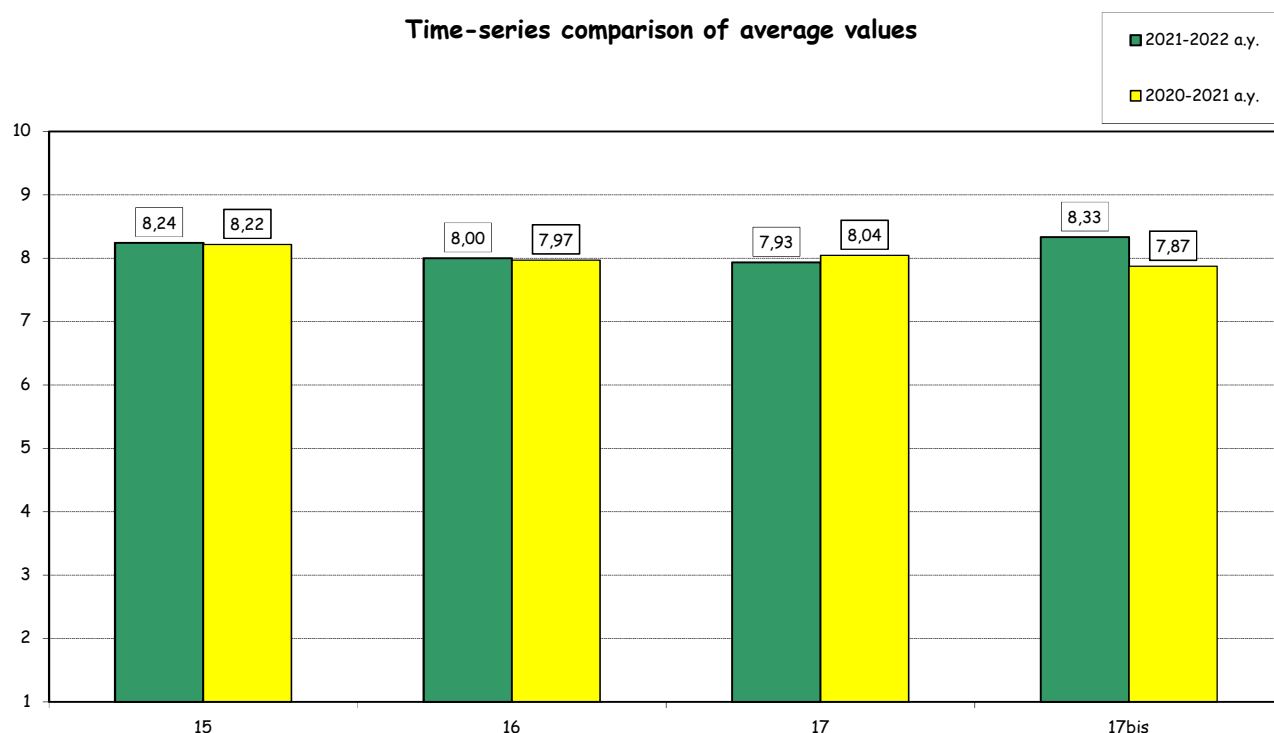

Time-series comparison of average values



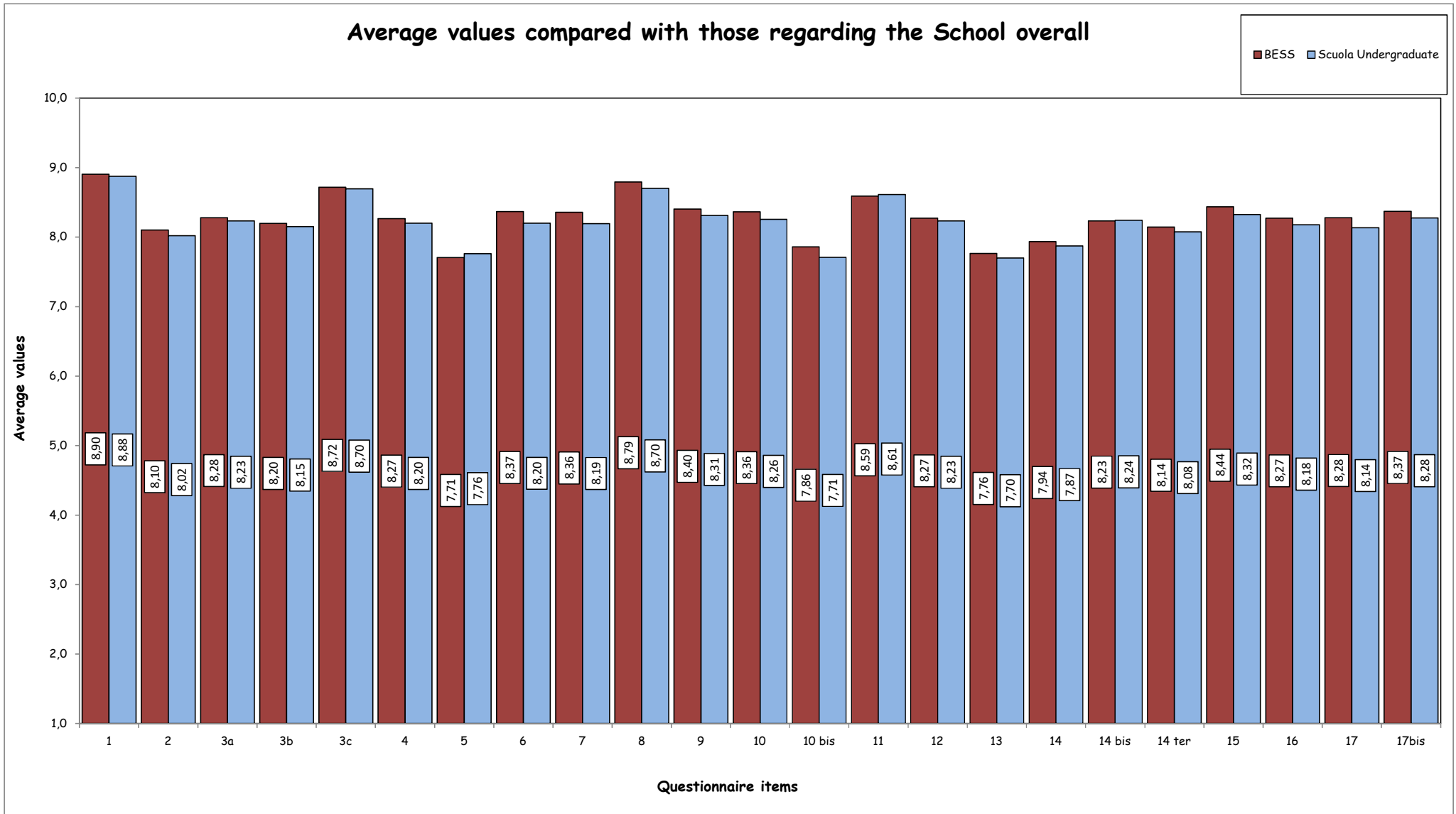

Average values compared with those regarding the School overall



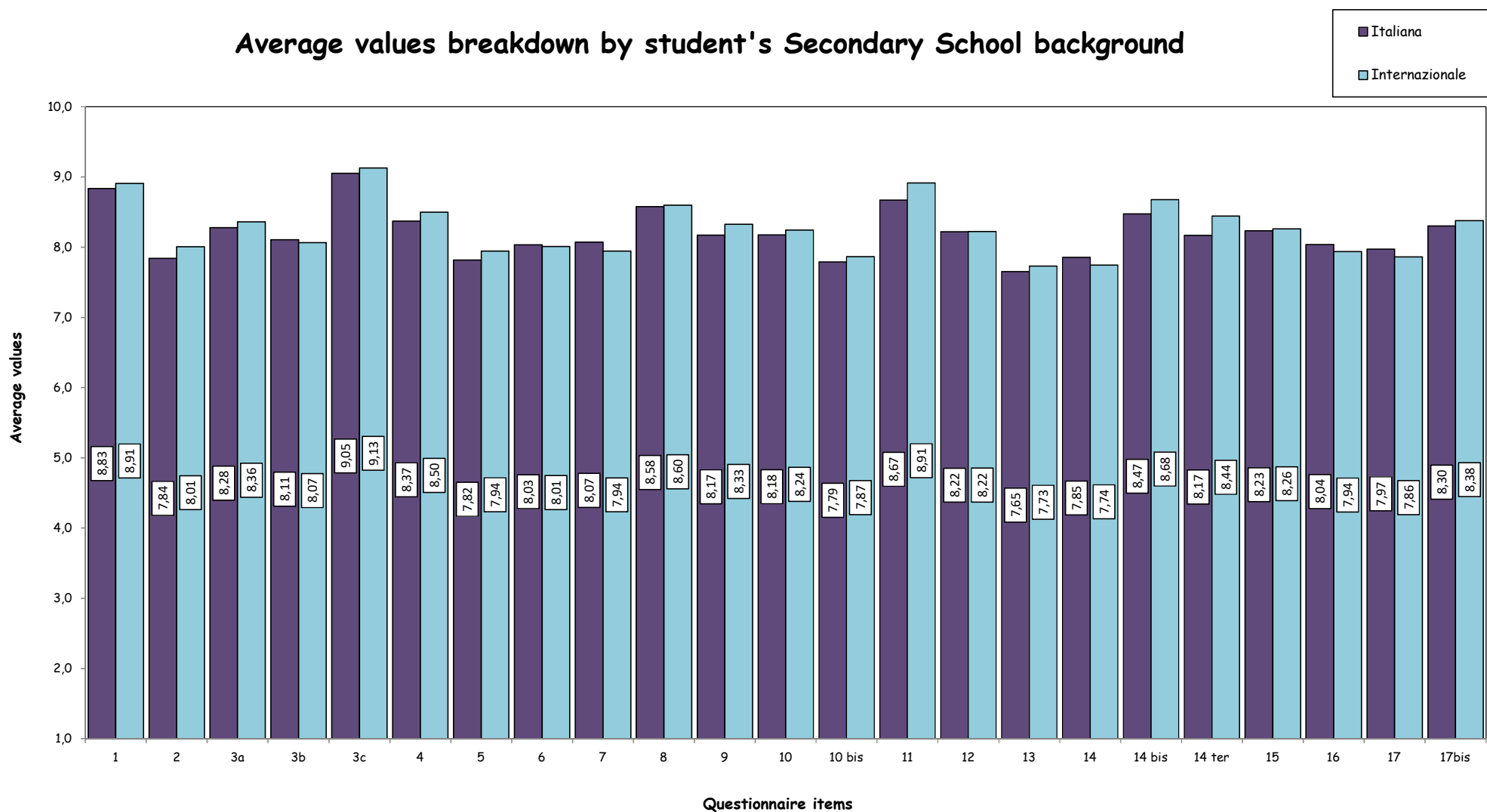

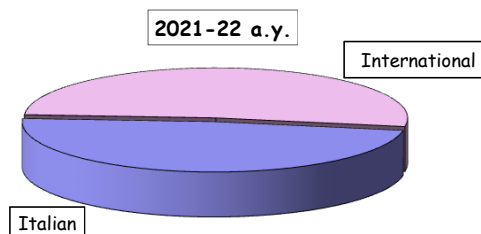

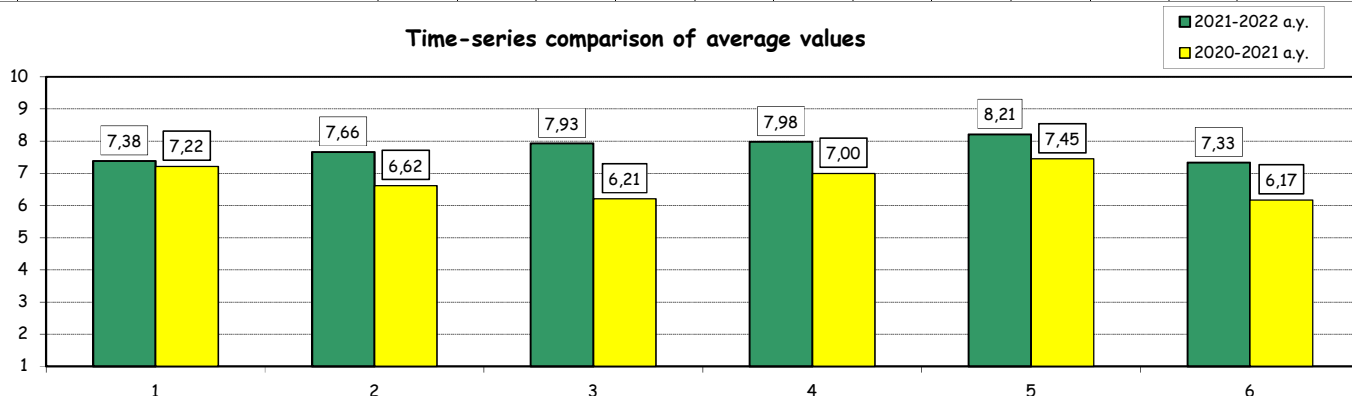
