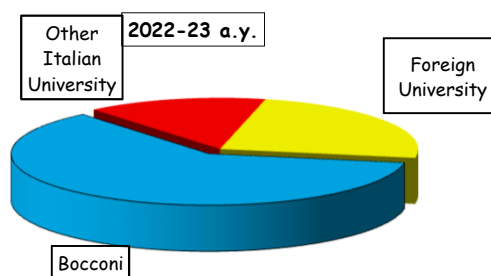

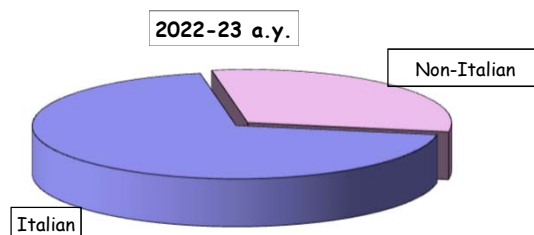

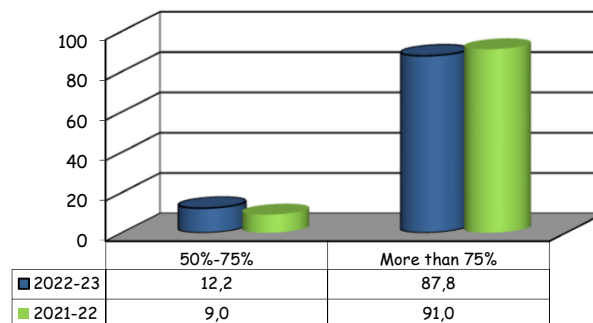

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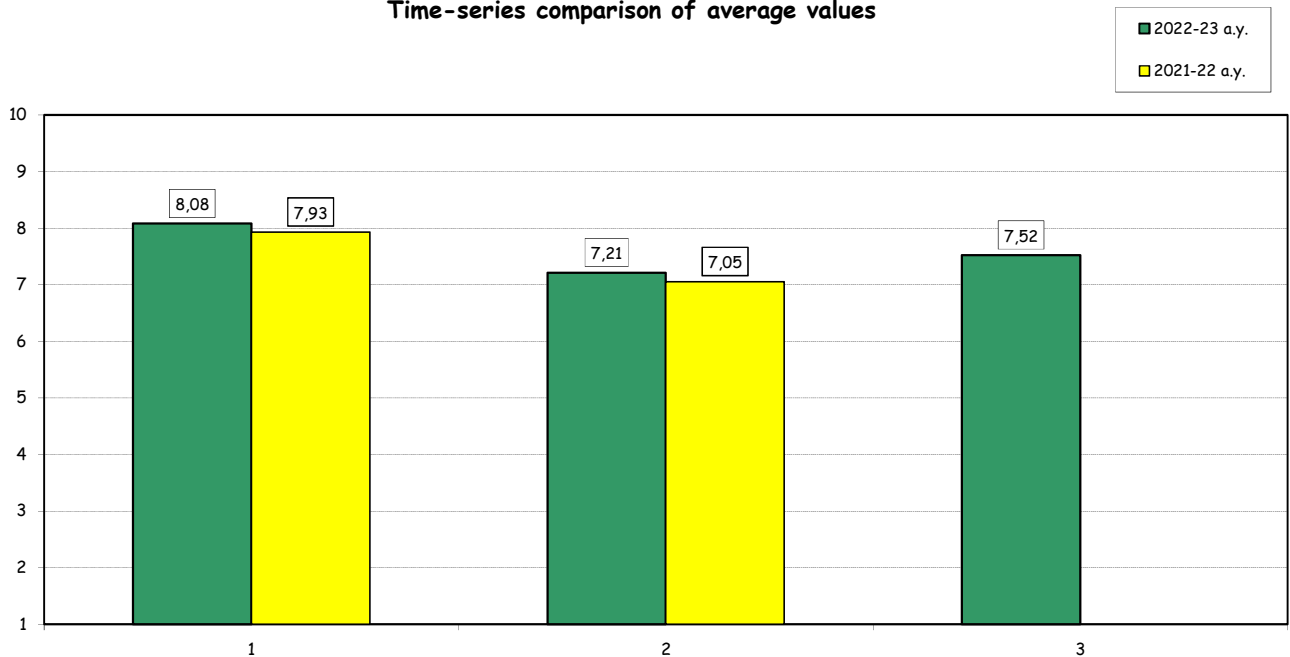

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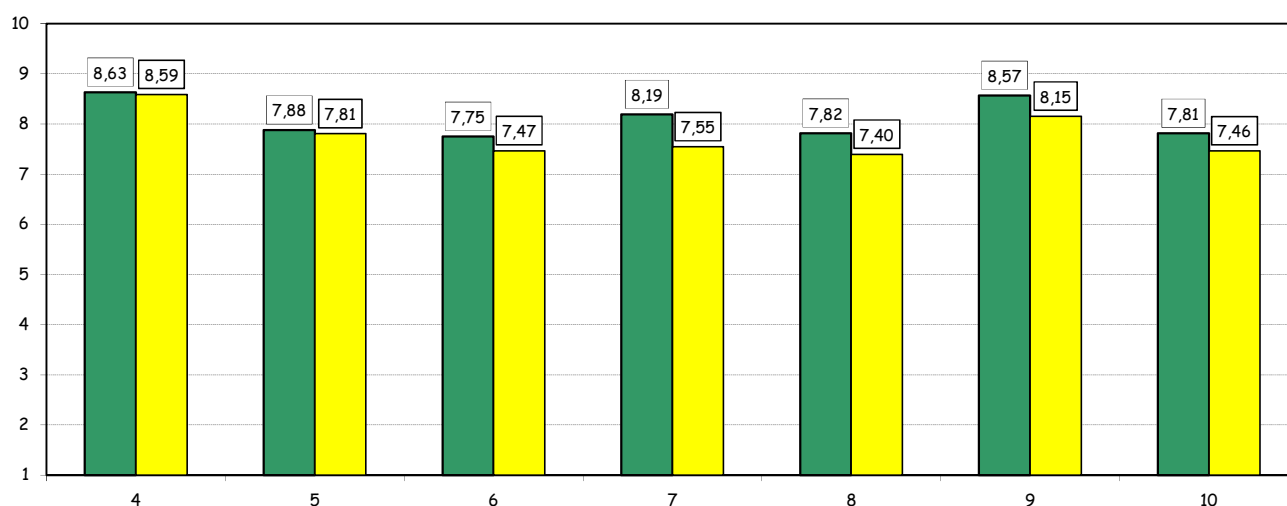

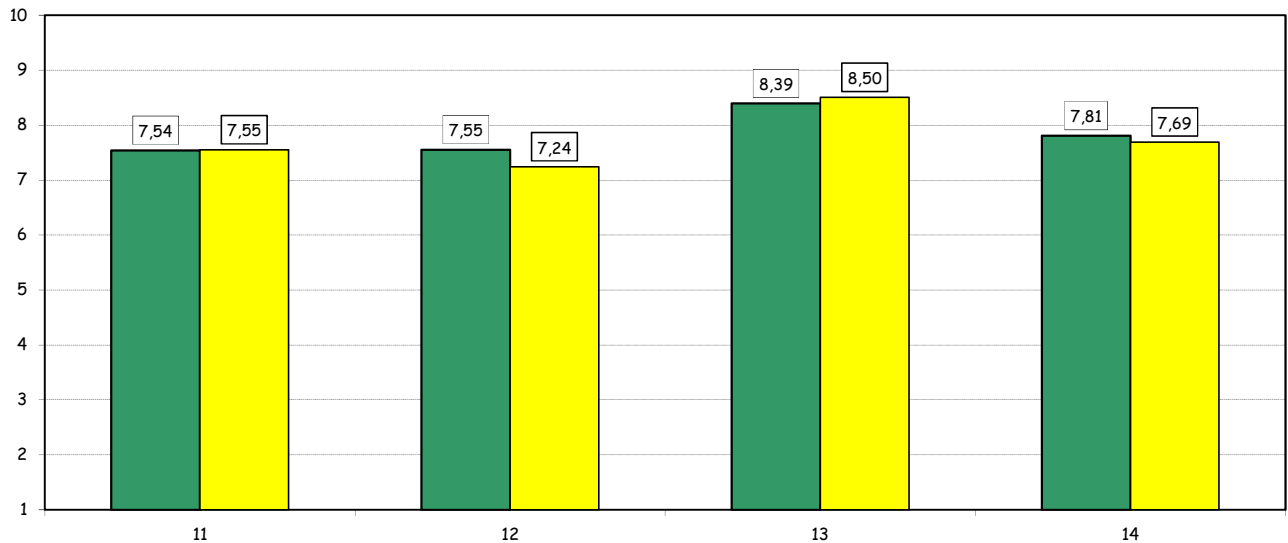

■ 2021-22 a.y.



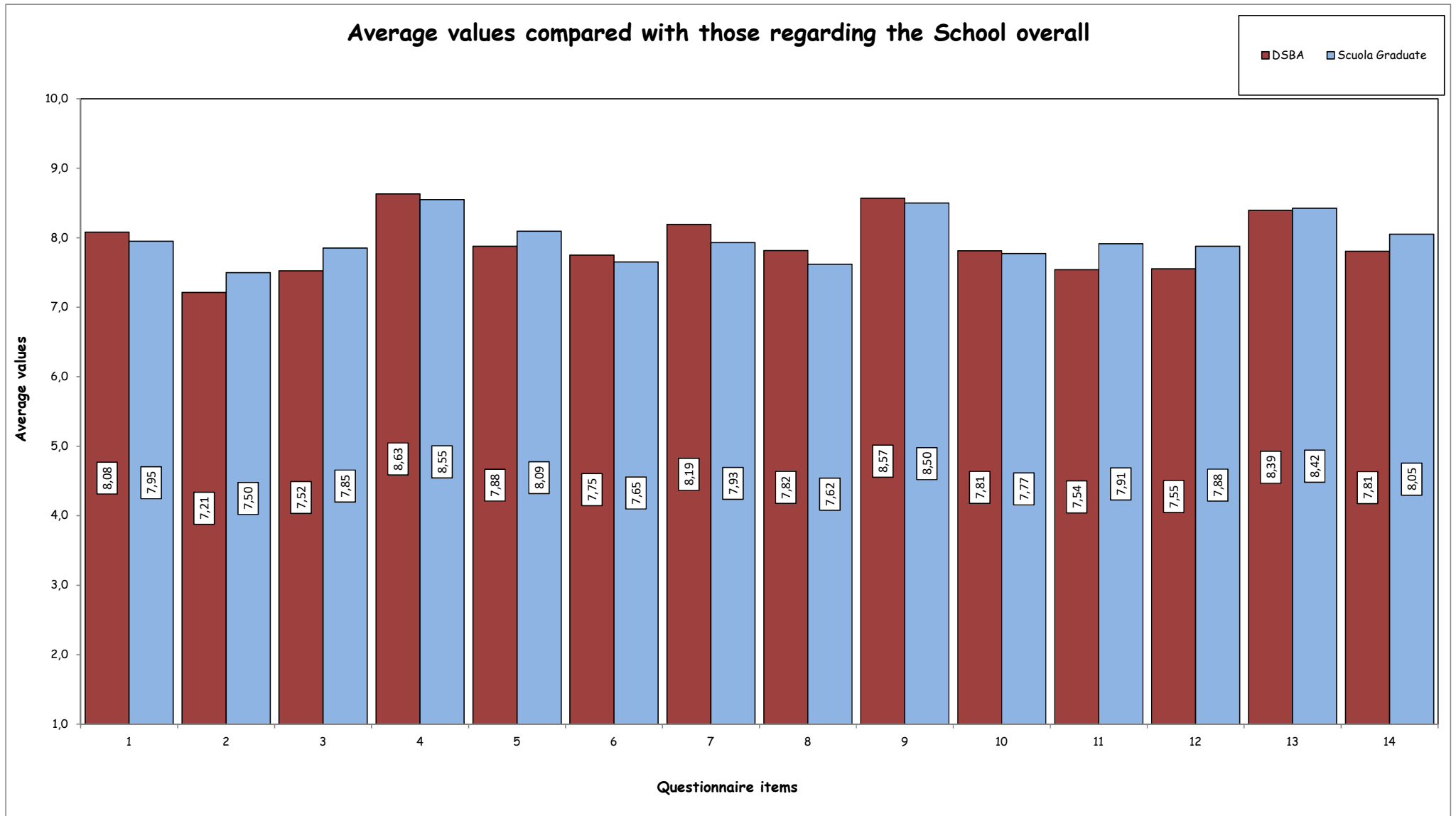

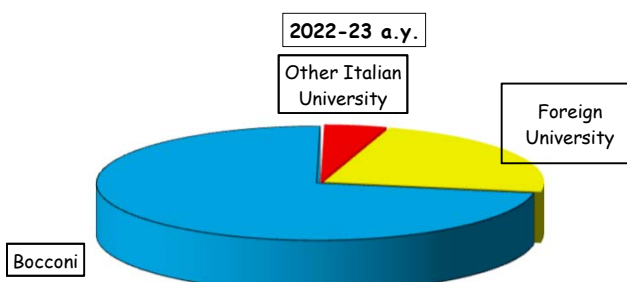

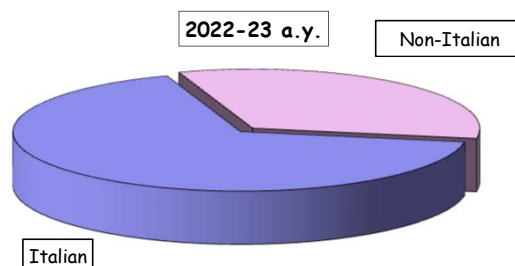

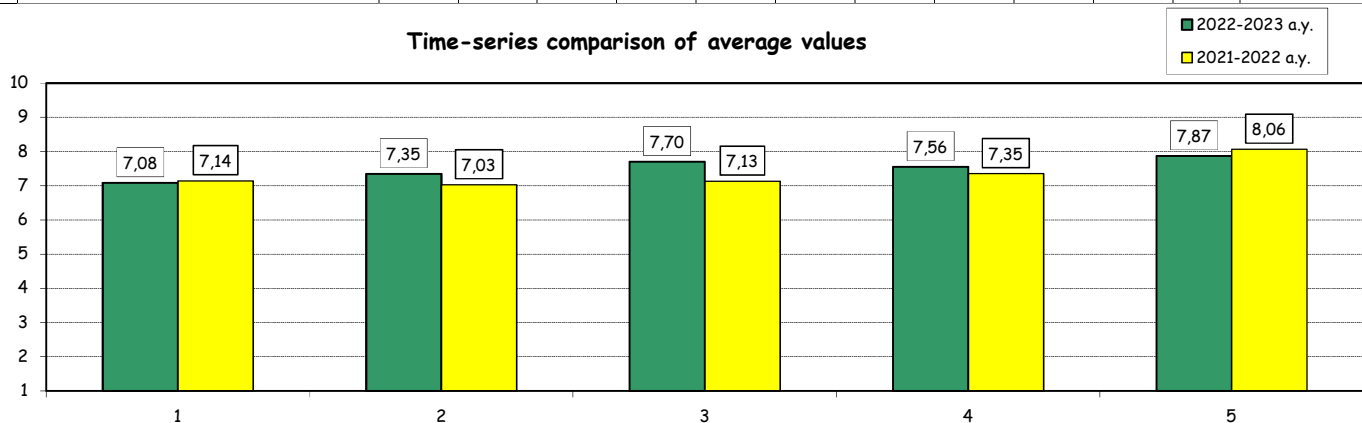
