BROADEN YOUR FRAME ETHICS AND MORAL PHILOSOPHY

SEMINAR SERIES 2024-2025

The six seminars examine selected themes at the interface between Economics and Moral Philosophy. Roberto Fumagalli, Senior Lecturer at King's College London, will illustrate the role of specific moral concepts and values in areas of major economic, philosophical and policy-making significance.

Roberto Fumagalli received his BA (2004) and MSc (2006) in Economic and Social Sciences from Bocconi University. He then completed both MSc (2007) and PhD (2011) in Philosophy at the London School of Economics. His research interests cover a wide range of areas, including Philosophy of Economics, Philosophy of Science, Moral and Political Philosophy, Philosophy and Public Policy.

He is Research Associate at the London School of Economics (since 2011) and Visiting Scholar at the University of Pennsylvania (since 2013) and has given more than 160 academic talks around the globe. Over the years, he has been responsible for several courses at the undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate level across universities. In 2017, he was awarded the Prize for Teaching Excellence at the University of Bayreuth. Since 2018, he has been nominated for multiple Teaching Excellence Awards and Education Awards at King's College London, where he has served as Director of the Philosophy, Politics and Economics Program (2018-20) and Director of the MA Public Policy Program (2021-24).
