

SURVEY ON GRADUATES SATISFACTION AT 1, 3, 5 YEARS AFTER GRADUATION - 2023 EDITION

BACHELOR IN INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS AND MANAGEMENT

INTRODUCTION

This statistical report summarizes the opinions expressed by graduates in response to satisfaction surveys carried out 1, 3 and 5 years after graduation.

The data reported refer to graduates who completed the Degree Program in the years 2021, 2019 and 2017, respectively, and who did not continue their studies at Bocconi.

In particular, the opinions gathered concern:

- satisfaction with the Program and the set of knowledge and skills acquired at the end of it;
- the perception of the usefulness of the Program for the performance of one's job;
- impressions of the contribution provided by internship and study experiences abroad (if applicable) for the job placement.

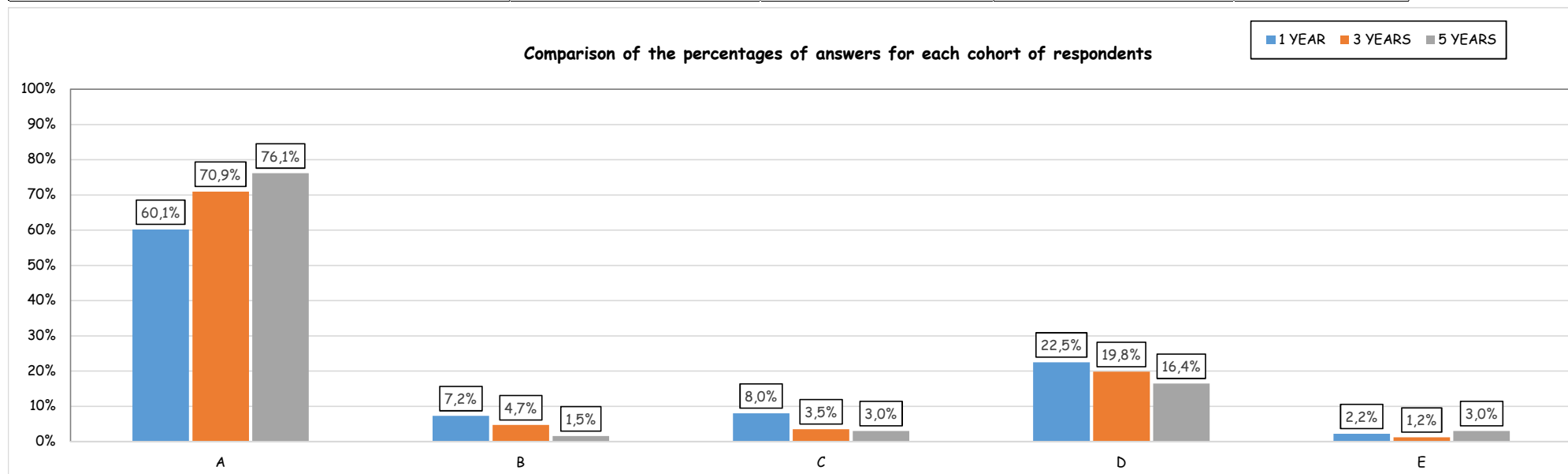

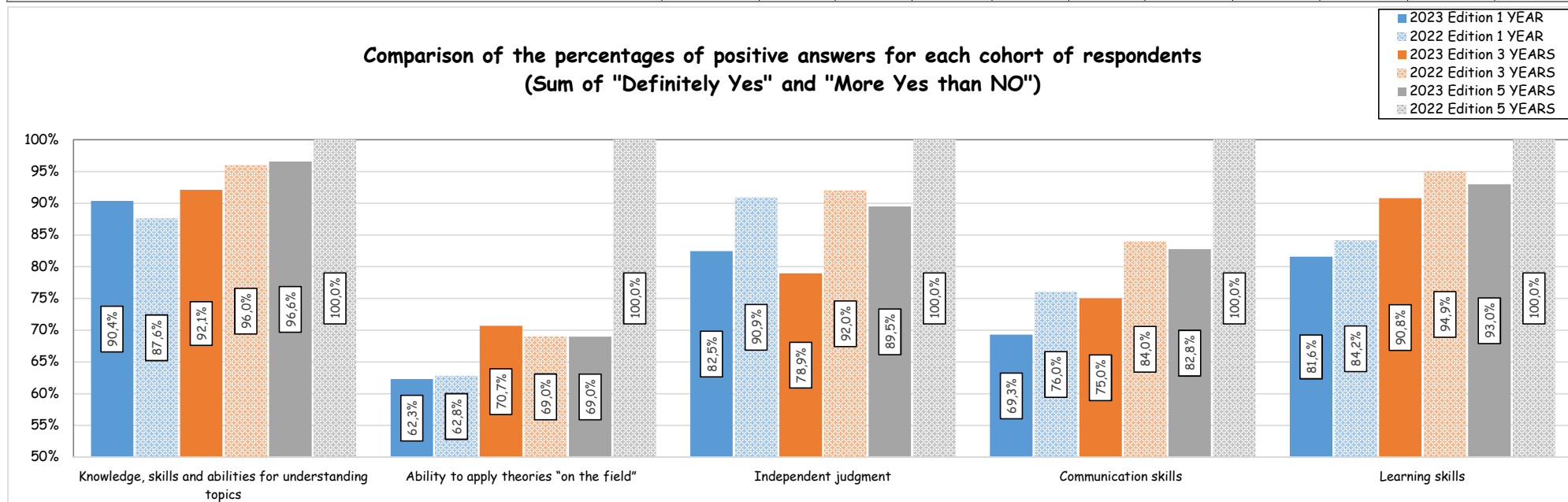

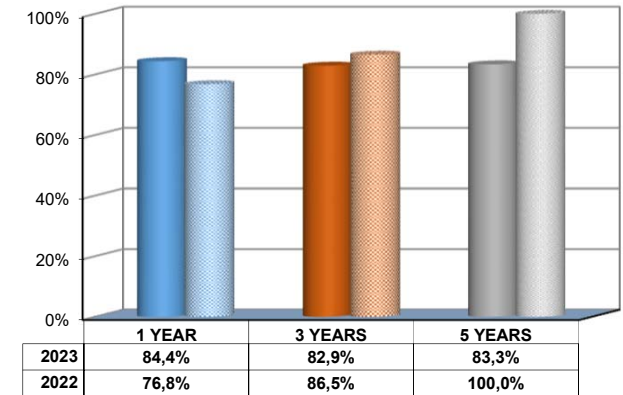

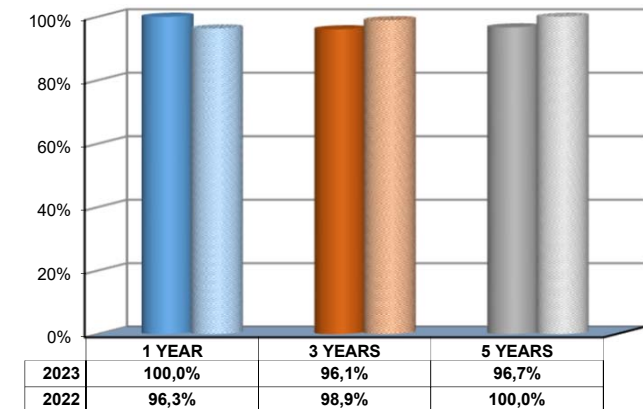
Temporal comparison of the percentages of positive answers

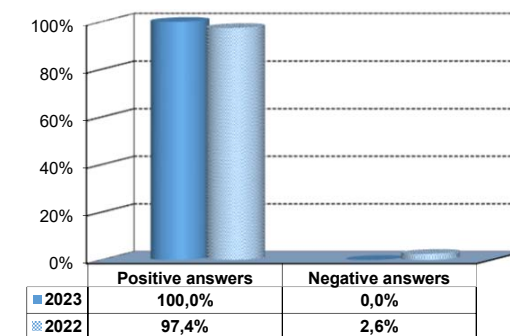
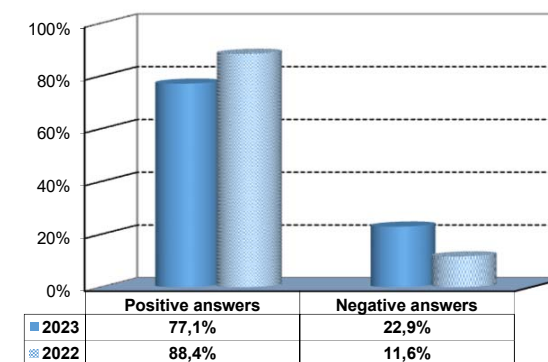
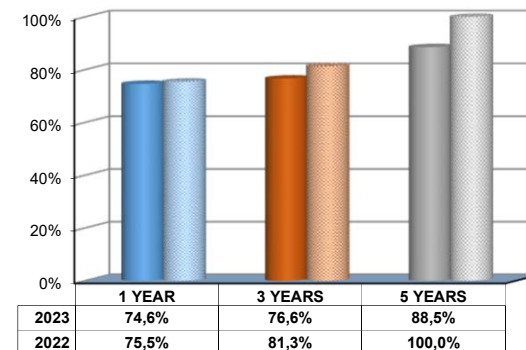
