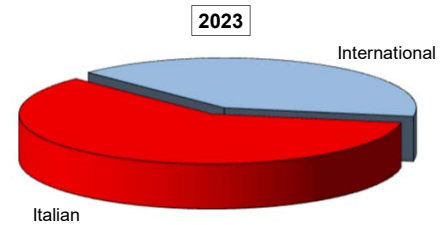

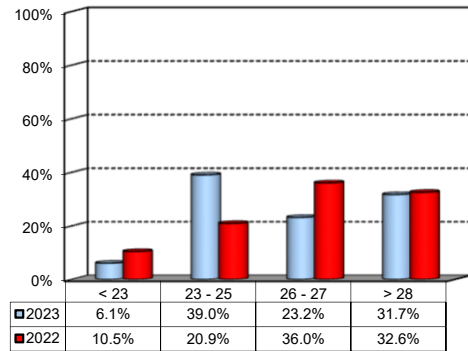

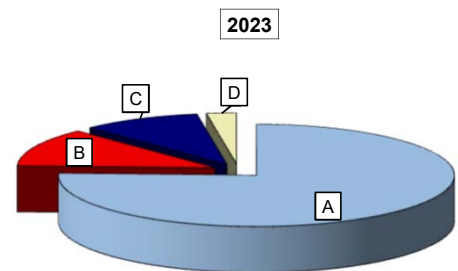

How many of the courses included in your curriculum did you attend regularly?

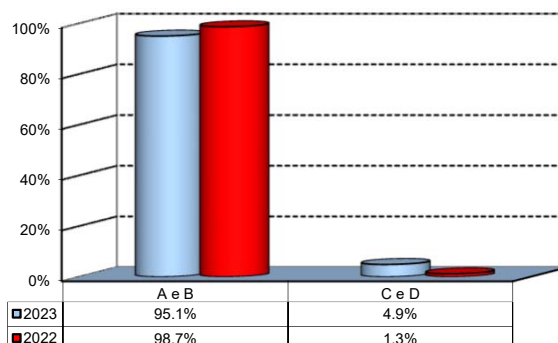

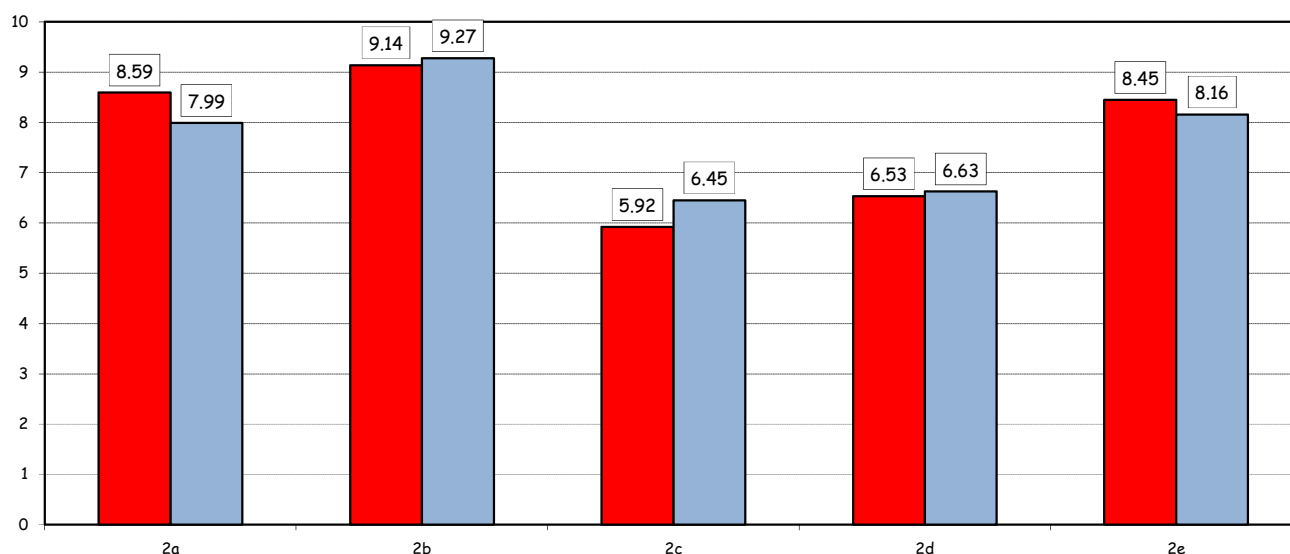

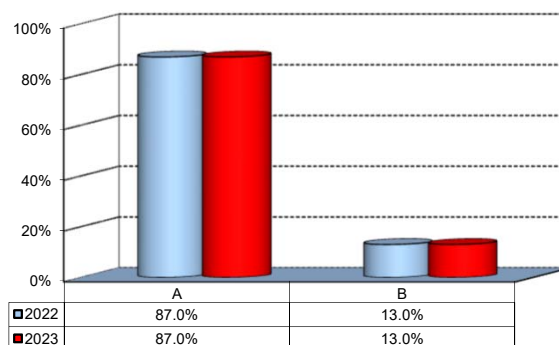

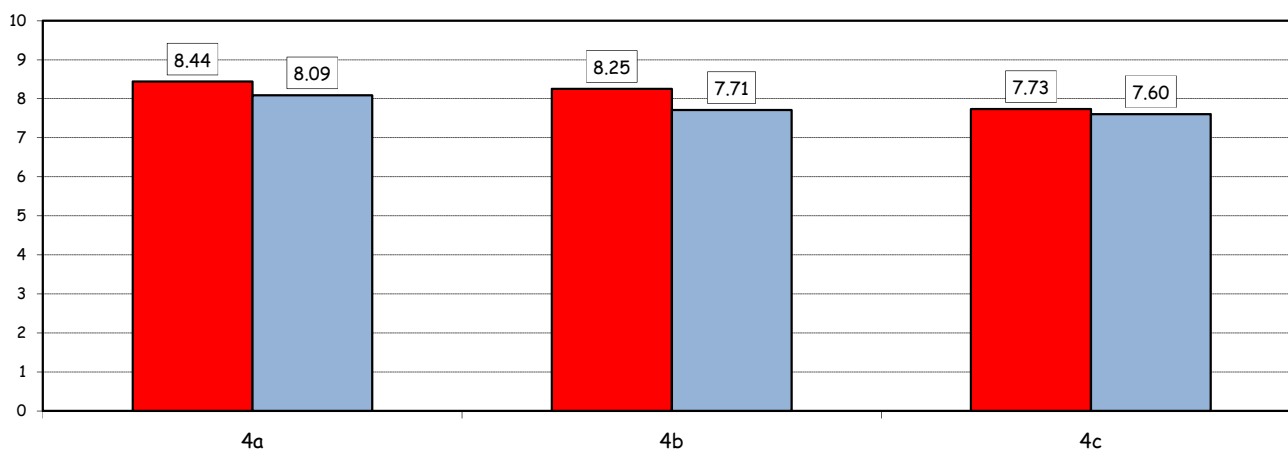

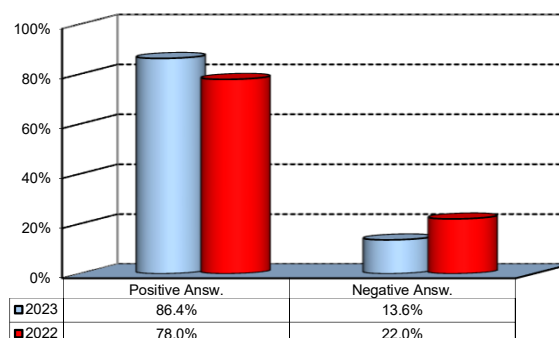
Over time comparison of average values

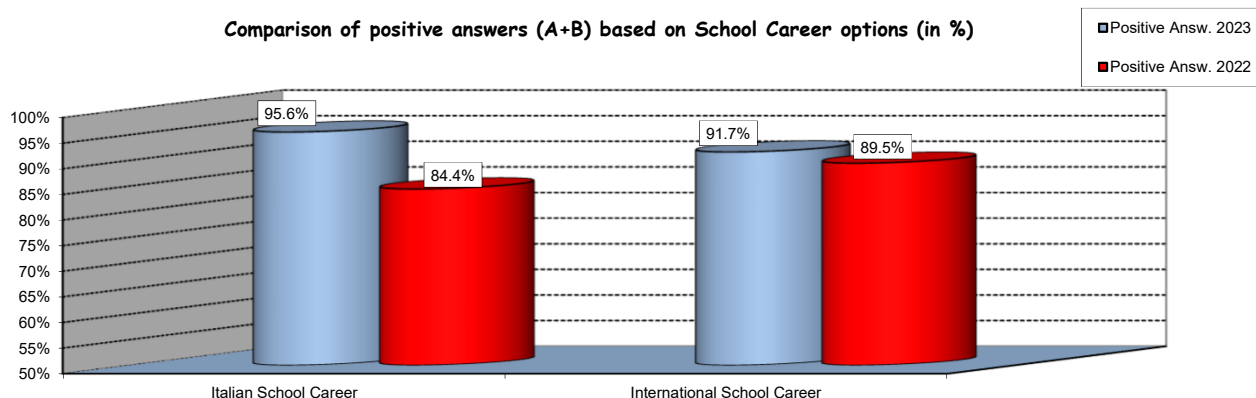

Comparison of positive answers (A+B) based on School Career options (in %)

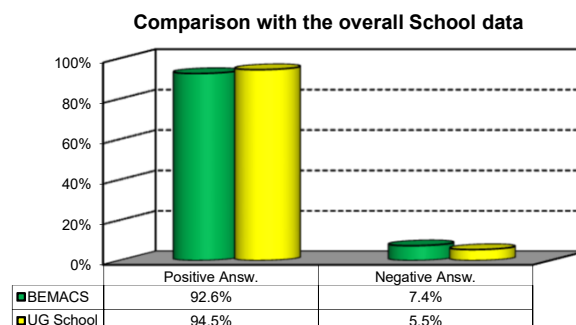
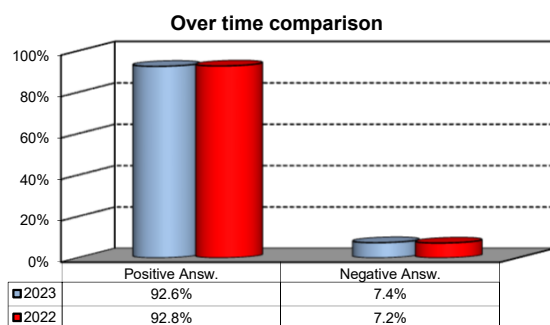

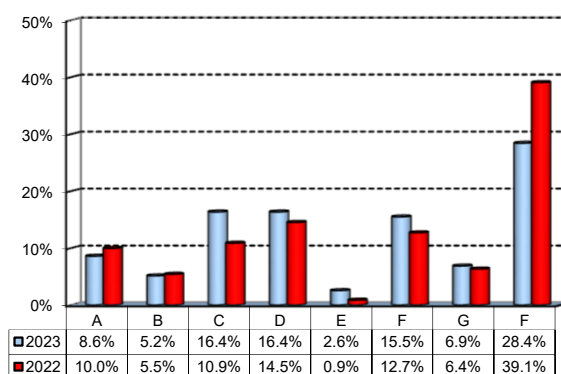

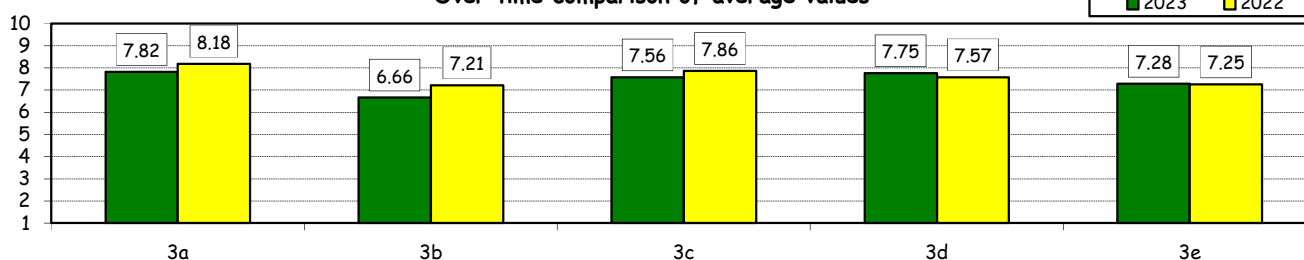

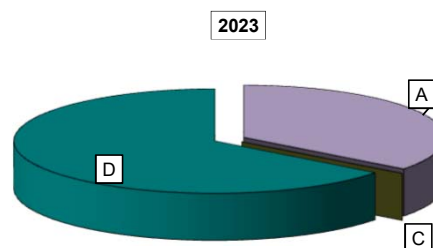
Over time comparison of average values

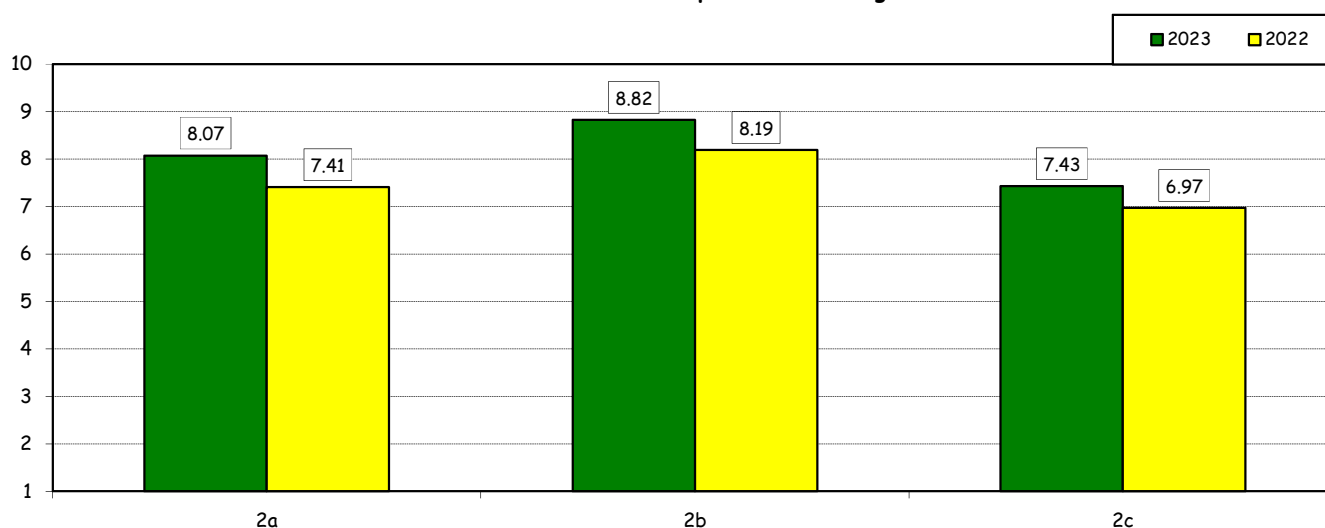

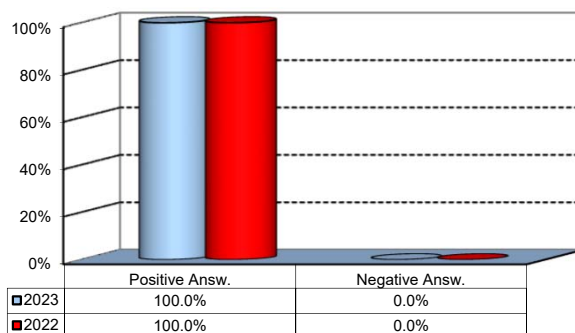
Over time comparison of average values

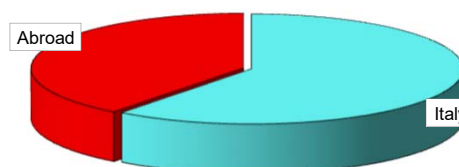

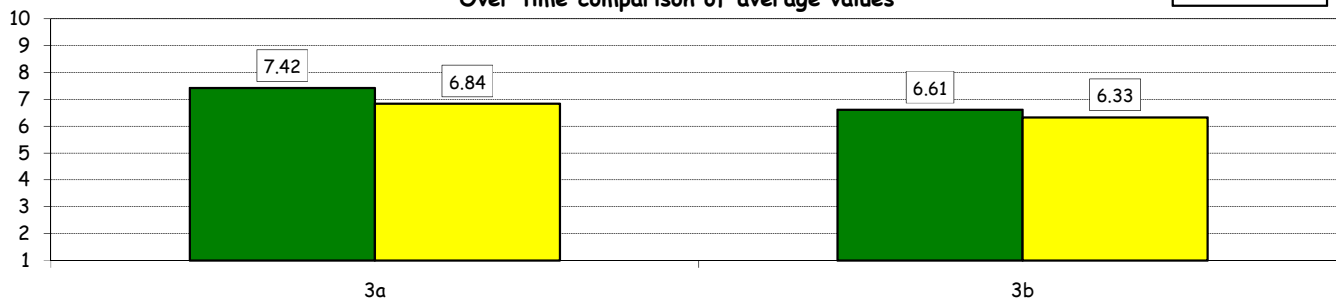

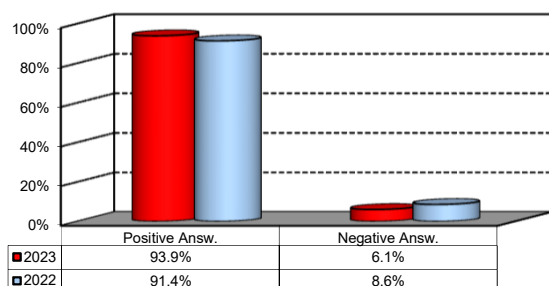

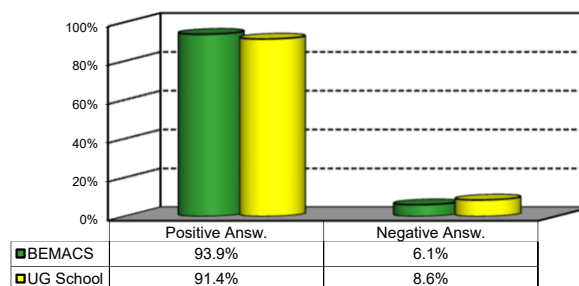

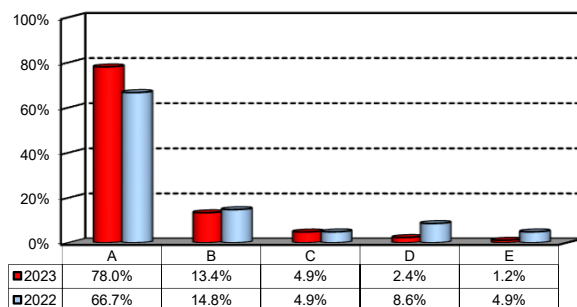
Comparison with the overall School data



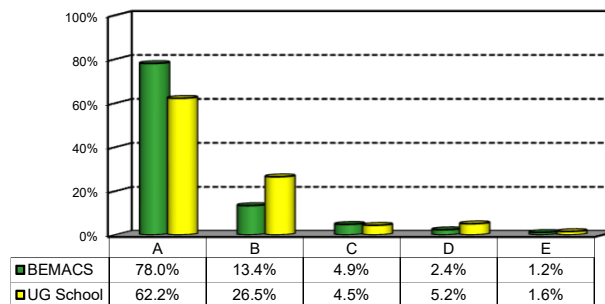

I initially wanted to apply to DSBA but since my GPA was not sufficient I was not admitted. Also, I would like to recommend that for the DSBA Master, you could implement some reserved spots for BEMACS students. Because in BEMACS it is harder to obtain a higher GPA than in other courses. DSBA should be like a continuation Master from BEMACS and I feel like by not giving reserved spots, BEMACS students don't get an equal opportunity to continue their master's studies at Bocconi.
