






Over time comparison






The professors & amp. guest speakers often could not coherently express ideas in English. Their written content was excellent but the oral transmission was lacking. I managed to get by because I learned Italian and could decipher their meaning most of the time

Unsatisfied with the italian teaching/evaluation system, it lacks critical thinking and relies on memorising. Lack of support for working students who are forced to follow the courses as 'non attending'.








