

## **PLOT**

This film is probably best understood as a documentary using "on the edge journalism", meaning that Michael Moore in his editing of scenes, interviews and chronological ordering of events stretches journalistic limits to make his point.

The U.S.A. is notorious for the number of its citizens killed by firearms in a developed country without a civil war. Michael Moore sets out to investigate the reasons and in doing so discovers that the conventional answers, such as easy availability of guns, violent national history, violent entertainment and even poverty are inadequate to explain this violence when other cultures share the same factors without the equivalent consequences. Why?

In order to arrive at a possible explanation, Moore examines America's general culture of fear, bigotry and violence in a nation of diffuse gun ownership. Furthermore he investigates the relationship between gun culture and corporate interests.

The film won an Oscar in 2003 for Best Documentary Feature.
