MINUTES

The evaluation committee composed of Prof. Francesco Billari (President), Prof. David Stuckler (Scientific coordinator of the project) and Prof. Arnstein Aassve (Secretary), nominated on 30 August 2017, prot. n. 8092 met on 6 September at 4:30 p.m. in the meeting room 3 C4 SR 01, in via Roentgen, 1, Milan.

According to the regulations of the competition, the Committee has concluded that the maximum scores to be allocated to admitted candidates are as follows:

- 40 points out of 100 for the evaluation of the CV, qualifications and publications
- 60 points out of 100 for the evaluation of the interview.

Only those candidates who achieve a score of at least 21 points for the evaluation of the CV, qualifications and publications will be invited to interview.

The total minimum score to be included in the ranking list is 60.

Having evaluated the applications submitted, the Commission has allocated the following scores for the evaluation of the CV, qualifications and publications:



The Committee confirms that the interview of the candidate Charoula Konstantia Nikolaou took place on 19 September 2017 at 6 p.m. via conference call (Skype).

The Commission asked the candidate a set of questions relating to her CV and experiences. At the end of the interview, the Committee, unanimously expressed and assigned her a score of 35 points.

The Committee acknowledges that the interview with the candidate Ankur Kumar Singh did not take place since he has decided to withdraw his application.

The Committee agrees that the total evaluation (CV, qualifications, publications and interviews) of each interviewed candidate is as follows:
